


FOOD BANK





ANASTASIIA

The Foundation decided to provide humanitarian aid to a Russian doctor, Anastasiia, who was able to escape from the front to which she was called.

During all these months, the Foundation provided her with accommodation, furniture, food, and covered all the expenses involved in the day-to-day life of any person. We also helped her with the legal procedures to be able to apply for political asylum.

Anastasiia wanted to collaborate with the school to reciprocate and was giving support to the Ukrainian students and families. Always with a smile and willing to help.

Incredible work and strength, struggling every day with the paperwork. Luckily, this summer, she was finally reunited with her family in the USA.



PROYECTO HOMBRE





As you all know PROYECTO HOMBRE is a non-profit foundation whose main aims are "the comprehensive care of drug addicts and, in general, the study, prevention and eradication of addictions and related problems of a personal, family, health and social nature, Promoting programmes aimed at the care and social inclusion of groups of people with addiction problems, HIV/AIDS, immigrants, prisoners and ex-prisoners, women, young people, minors and ethnic minorities in social difficulty, encouraging in our actions the participation of social volunteers and equal opportunities between men and women. Promoting and carrying out training activities aimed at the socio-labour integration of the beneficiary groups and the training of educators, mediators and other social agents. All of this in the province of Seville".

This agreement signed between the two foundations consists of the commitment made by The Yago Foundation to subscribe to a SCHOLARSHIP for one year to cover the costs of rehabilitation and reintegration into the labour market of a PERSON in the Youth Programme of Proyecto Hombre Seville, aimed at adolescents at risk of social exclusion due to their addictions. In its desire to contribute to the education of our youth and to collaborate with as many solidarity actions as possible, The Yago Foundation has wanted to contribute its grain of sand to this commendable work that PROYECTO HOMBRE carries out in our society.





EXPRESS VOLUNTEERING







The aim of Express Volunteering is threefold: To provide timely help with an immediate impact by sheltering homeless people in different cities in Spain. Raise money in a single day (9 hours), buy shelter material in the afternoon and distribute it that same night. As they do every year, our students take to the streets of Seville for a whole night to give shelter to the homeless so that they can take refuge from the cold.

OLIVE OIL COLLECTION





Every year we collaborate with Cáritas Parroquial and we try to cover their needs, last December they needed oil due to its price increase.
